Having a first aid kit can make a difference in an emergency situation. Below is a list of items that should be included in your kit. Remember to check your kit twice a year and update as needed. Always consult with your veterinarian before attempting to treat a medical condition or an injury.

- Antibiotic Ointment for Wounds
- Bandage Scissors
- Bandage Tape
- Betadine or Nolvasan Scrub and Solution
- Cotton Bandage Rolls
- Cotton Tipped Swabs
- Elastic Bandage Rolls
- Isopropyl Alcohol/Alcohol Prep Pads
- Tweezers
- Eye Rinse (sterile)
- Latex Gloves or Non-allergenic Gloves
- Medications(minimum 2 week supply)
- Non-adherent Bandage Pads
- Saline Solution
- Sterile Lubricant
- Thermometer
- Tourniquet
- Towel and Washcloth
- Large and Small Gauze
- Vet Wrap
- Hydrogen Peroxide
- Number for Animal Poison Hotline
- Number for Poison Control for Pets
- Instant Hot & Cold Compresses
