

Storing memories and special items that remind them of their animal allows them to revisit their companion animal whenever they need or want to. On the following page, you will find suggestions for what you could include in your animal's memory box. Please use them as suggestions to honour your animal in the best way you see fit.

It is important to remember that the items stored within the memory box should be items that can be stored safely.
